## Free childcare offer

The nursery accepts 2-, 3- & 4-year-old funding. The new 2-year-old funding for 15 hours is available from April '24 for children of working parents. You must be working the equivalent of 16 hours at the national minimum wage and no more than £100,000 per year. A child becomes eligible for this the term after their 2nd birthday.

If you would like to access this funding, then please visit www.gov.uk for how to apply.

3- & 4-year-olds - we accept 15- and 30-hours funding for all 3- and 4-year-olds. Any child aged 3 can access 15 hours funding and for 30 hours funding both parents need to be working with the same eligibility as the 2-year-old funding above.

We will also be offering the new funding for 9-month-olds from September '24. The government website is urging parents to start applying for funding from 12<sup>th</sup> May 2024 when applications open.
